

SECTION 00030 - ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
BARNSTABLE FIRE DISTRICT, BARNSTABLE, MASSACHUSETTS

Sealed bids for “Cleaning, Painting and Rehabilitation of Water Storage Tanks 2 and 3,” for the Barnstable Fire District Water Department, acting by its Board of Water Commissioners, will be received at the Barnstable Fire District Water Department, 1841 Phinney’s Lane, P.O. Box 546, Barnstable, Massachusetts 02630 until 2:00 PM on February 15, 2018, and at that time publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of furnishing all labor, tools, materials, staging, power and equipment necessary for the cleaning, painting, replacement, and alteration of tank appurtenances, including automation of valves, removal of valves, addition of mixing systems, removal of a mixing system, replacement of instrumentation, removal and disposal of lead coating, and temporary pumping. All work shall be completed within 365 consecutive calendar days after Notice to Proceed.

The Contract Documents, including Specifications and Drawings, may be examined at the Barnstable Fire District Water Department, 1841 Phinney’s Lane, P.O. Box 546, Barnstable, Massachusetts 02630 and at the office of Stantec Consulting Services Inc., 5 Burlington Woods – 2nd Floor Clerk’s Office, Burlington, Massachusetts 01803 on and after January 24, 2018 every weekday between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M., and copies thereof may be obtained at Stantec Consulting Services Inc. upon payment of \$50.00 (checks only) for each set, for which a refund will be made if returned to Stantec in good condition within thirty days after the opening of bids. No refund will be made for documents received after this period. If a bidder requests drawings and specifications to be mailed out to him, an additional check in the amount of \$25.00 made out to “Stantec Consulting Services Inc.” shall be required. This is to cover the cost of mailing and handling and will not be refunded.

Each bid must be accompanied by bid security in the form of certified check, cashier’s check, treasurer’s check or bid bond in an amount not less than 5 percent of the value of the bid. A performance bond and a labor and material payment bond, each in an amount equal to 100 percent of the contract price, will be required.

A Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Payment Bond, each in an amount equal to 100 percent of the contract price, will be required for the faithful performance of the Contract and provided within ten (10) calendar days of the award letter. The right is reserved to waive any informalities in or to reject any or all bids received, and to award the contract to any of the Contractors bidding on the work if, in the District’s opinion, the best interests of the District thereby will be promoted.

Attention of bidders is called particularly to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract as determined by the Commissioner of the Department of Labor, Division of Occupational Safety, under the provisions of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26-27H inclusive.

The successful bidder shall be required to submit documentation that all employees to be employed in the work subject to this bid have successfully completed a course in construction safety and health approved by the United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration that is at least 10 hours in duration. Any employee found on a worksite subject to this Section without documentation of successful completion of a course in construction safety and health approved by the United States Occupational Safety and Health Administration that is at least 10 hours in duration shall be subject to immediate removal.
