**BARNSTABLE FIRE DISTRICT-OFFICE WINDOWS, DOORS, TRIM, AND SIDING

INVITATION TO BID

The Barnstable Fire District Board of Water Commissioners, Barnstable, Massachusetts will receive sealed Bids to Furnish and Install New Windows, Doors, Trim, Siding and Appurtenant Work at the Water Department Office, until March 8, 2018 at 2:00 P.M., local time, at the office of the Barnstable Fire District Board of Water Commissioners, 1841 Phinney's Lane, P.O. Box 546, Barnstable, MA 02630 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. All Bids shall be submitted within a sealed envelope addressed to the "Office of the Barnstable Fire District Board of Water Commissioners, 1841 Phinney's Lane, P.O. Box 546, Barnstable, MA 02630 " and entitled "**Barnstable Fire District-Office Windows, Doors, Trim, and Siding Replacement Project 2018**"

The project, contract FY2018-01, consists of removing eleven (11) windows, three (3) doors, trim, and siding. The project also consists of installing eleven (11) high energy-efficient windows, 3 entry doors, trim, and siding.

The Contractor shall supply all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work hereinafter contained in the Specifications. All employees that are to work on this project will have to have completed at least the 10 hour OSHA training on construction safety and health. Prevailing Wage Rates as determined by the Massachusetts Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development shall apply to the labor force on this project.

The Bidder must provide documentation with the bid that demonstrates that his/her firm has a minimum of five (5) recent years of experience in construction and remodeling of like projects.

Contract bid will be by the lump sum price method as indicated on the Bid Form. No Bidder may withdraw his/her Bid for a period of ninety (90) days after the date designated above for the opening.

All bids for this project are subject to the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30, Section 39M as amended and Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 - 27b inclusive and Section 44A - 44I inclusive. Attention is directed to the minimum wage rates to be paid on the work as determined by the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids or to accept any Bid deemed by them to be in the best interest of the Barnstable Fire District and to limit the extent of the work to keep within the limits of available funds.

To receive consideration, bids shall be submitted on the appropriate forms, and must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of **five percent (5%) of the bid price** in the form of a bid bond or certified treasurer's check or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Payment Bond in the amount of 50% of the Contract.
